Description:

This work represent one of the three moments of the project "I am still not sure how long we will stay here and where we will go then". Each moment consists of two images that must be positioned side by side. One of the images is the result of a glass negative whose initial image has partially or totally disappeared because of the corrosion of the different temporal agents and the expansion of the silver nitrate over its surface. When inverting these negatives to positives, their tones approach different hues of blue. The other image consists of a landscape that results from a film negative.

There is a relationship between the juxtaposed images in the very uncertainty that both establish and in the existing mismatch - the mismatch of the image, of the path, of time.
