Description:

Working predominantly in photography and film for over three decades, Tracey Moffatt is known as a powerful visual storyteller. The narrative is often implied and self-referential, exploring her own childhood memories, and the broader issues of race, gender, sexuality and identity.

The video "Mother" is composed of extracts of various films or TV series showing the various relations between mother and child. It was created in collaboration with Gary Hillberg.

Her videos have been exhibited in all major museums in the world under the title « Tracey Moffatt & Gary Hillberg Montages: The Full Cut 1999-2015 (Travelling Exhibition) ». Moffatt represented Australia at The Venice Biennale in 2017
