Description:

12 photograms, 1 photograph, black-and-white silver gelatin prints on glossy Ilford baryta paper, wooden board, 2 mm glass, wooden moulding, acid-free black fabric tape, oxidized lead, metal plates, magnets.

overall dimensions: 114 × 110 cm

Photographs of the earliest human-made objects representing human bodies - dating from between 3 million and 16,000 years ago - are surrounded by photograms of broken fluorescent tubes, whose accidental spiral fractures evoke the shape of DNA. The compositions, each unique in the "Emergence Matriarcale" series, function as mementos, recalling both the fortuitous nature of our existence and our distant origins.
